

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS AGENCY REGISTRATION

In order to be considered for registration, the following items must be submitted:
\$200 registration fee (cash, cheque or money order made payable to AGLC).
Application for Liquor Agency Registration (Form 5248).
Criminal Record Check (must be original and obtained within the last 90 days) from the RCMP or local
police for all requested directors and shareholders of the applicant company.
Particulars of Individual (Form 5013) completed by all directors and shareholders.
Particulars of Incorporation of Company (Form 5231).
Particulars of Shareholding Company (Form 5231) if applicable.
Certificate of Incorporation for the applicant company showing registration in Alberta.
Acknowledgement and Undertaking (Form 5228-1)
Once <u>all</u> documents and fees have been submitted and approved, an AGLC Inspector will initiate contact with the applicant to make arrangements to review operating procedures. Note: AGLC Product & Pricing or Finance may contact you for additional items after the registration has been issued.
