

Cannabis Product Transfers

June 15, 2021

This bulletin is to advise all cannabis licensees of an amendment to the Retail Cannabis Store Handbook (RCSH).

Effective immediately, transfers of cannabis products between chain stores owned by the same entity no longer require prior AGLC approval.

Stores that are permanently closing and selling their remaining stock to another licensee will continue to be required to request AGLC approval for the transaction.

As per Federal cannabis monthly reporting requirements, retailers that transfer or purchase cannabis products will be required to report the movement of product as outlined on [AGLC's Cannabis Portal](#) at <https://apps.aglc.ca/CannabisPortal>.
