**Liquor Licensing of Spas, Salons and Barbershops** 

Effective immediately, spas, salons and barbershops will be eligible for a <u>Class B liquor licence</u> from the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (AGLC).

The applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Offer approved esthetic services such as manicures, pedicures, facials, makeup applications, skin treatments and haircutting and styling;
- Meet all municipal licensing requirements including zoning, fire, and health requirements;
- Offer a selection of hot or cold food items suitable for a light meals or snack;
- Staff serving liquor must have <u>ProServe</u> liquor staff training certification.

We encourage interested applicants to read the relevant policy for full licensing requirements. The policy may be found under Section 3.5 of the <u>Liquor Licensee Handbook</u>. Applicants can review all liquor related polices and requirements at <u>aglc.ca</u>.
